Day 1 Kuala Lumpur / Moscow (D)

Depart to **Moscow** - the capital of Russia, its political, scientific, historical, architectural and business centre, from which power and might of the Russian state developed. Upon arrival, transfer to **Sparrow Hills**, enjoy the panoramic view of the Moscow city and view the impressive complex of buildings of the Lomonosov Moscow University.

Day 2 Moscow~Kremlin (B/L/D)

Today, our sightseeing tour begin with walking tour to Kremlin and Red Square. **The Kremlin**, situated in the very center of the capital of Russia. Its monumental walls and towers, golden-domed cathedrals and ancient palaces forming a magnificent architectural ensemble, listed as UNESCO World Heritage. Visit the **Armoury Chamber** - the oldest museum in Russia presents ancient Russian regalia, ceremonial tsar's dress, church hierarchs' vestments, gold and silverware, arms and armouries, royal carriages and horse ceremonial harness. Since 1991, the Kremlin has been the official residence of the President of the Russian Federation. After lunch, continue journey to **The Red Square**, the focal point of the city, the square lies on the east wall of the Kremlin surrounded by a thick red fortress wall containing 20 towers all at various intervals. The square separates the Kremlin, the former royal citadel and currently the official residence of the President of Russia. A photo stop at **Lenin's Mausoleum**, now still the resting place of the embalmed body of the founder of Soviet Communism some 76 years after his death. Admire the iconic symbol of Russia - **St. Basil's Cathedral**, one of the unique Old Russian architecture with brightly colored ensemble consists of eight chapels topped with onion domes. Have some free time to shop at the most expensive façade of the world – famous **GUM Departmental Store**. This evening enjoy the famous and thrilling **world class Moscow State Circus Show**.

Day 3 Moscow (1st Class Overnight Train) / St. Petersburg (B/L/D)

Pay a visit to **Izmailovsky Flea Market**, a bustling market with hundred of stalls selling souvenirs, paintings, local handicraft crafts such as Matryoshka dolls, fur hats. Discover the famous **Moscow Metro Station (subway)** well known as the Underground Palace of Moscow and the most beautiful underground system in the World. Each station is lavishly decorated with marble, mosaic and stained-glass. Your guide will lead you to take a ride to few fantastic stations. Take a walk on this oldest street in Moscow- **Arbat Street**, shop for some crafts and souvenirs. After dinner, heading to train station for our **1st class overnight train (2 persons in 1 cabin) to St. Petersburg** – the second largest city of Moscow.

Day 4 St. Petersburg (B/L/D)

Upon arrival, transfer to restaurant for hearty **dim sum breakfast**. **St. Petersburg City Orientation Tour include The Palace Square, passing by Nevsky Prospect Boulevard - the main street of St. Petersburg. A stop at Bronze Horseman Statue and Decembrist square and Savior on Spilled Blood Church**. Visit the **St. Isaac's Cathedral**, is the fourth largest domed cathedral in the world. A bridge across the Neva river, visit the **Peter and Paul Fortress**, including the first cathedral in St. Petersburg, is the birthplace and oldest landmark in St. Petersburg, was built by Peter the Great with the purpose of defense from the Swedish navy during the Great Northern War. Thereafter, a relaxing **cruise along Neva river**.

Day 5 St. Petersburg~Peterhof (B/L/D)

Highlights for today is the **UNESCO World Heritage Site Peterhof Grand Palace and Park**, a royal summer residence with a series of palaces, gardens and fountains, laid out on the orders of Peter the Great, also known as the "Russian Versailles". Visit The **Hermitage Museum**, Russia's best gallery of world art, home to million of arts and artifacts from Ancient Egypt to early 20th century Europe. Tonight, attend a **Russian dinner with folklore show performance**.

Day 6 St. Petersburg / Kuala Lumpur (B)

After breakfast, free at leisure till transfer to airport for your flight back to Kuala Lumpur.
